


November 2020 Progress Report


Vessel traffic monitoring information for the <u>Voluntary Protection Zone (VPZ) for Shipping on the West Coast of Haida Gwaii</u> is provided through the <u>Enhanced Maritime Situational</u>

<u>Awareness</u> system and the Pacific Safety Initiative (US). Vessel passages are monitored off the west coast of Haida Gwaii to a distance of 200 nm.

During the month of November 2020, 78% of targeted commercial vessels transited outside the VP7.¹



¹ Monitoring results include commercial vessels over 500 gross tons transiting within 200 nautical miles of the west coast of Haida Gwaii.
